## *He was amazed at their lack of faith*

Being humble is a important characteristics of our Lord Jesus Christ. In today's gospel reading Mark 6:1-6, Jesus returns to his hometown of Nazareth, where he teaches in the synagogue. Although the townspeople were initially amazed at all of his wisdom and miracles he was performing, their attention quickly became skeptical and questioning Him. Even though they were seeing miracles they severely lacked faith. The townspeople questioned how a mere carpenter could have such authority. How could someone they knew most of their life be divine? Their lack of faith blinded them from Jesus's divine nature & mission.

Jesus also shows us how the townspeople's lack of faith limited him in how much he can do. It underscores the importance that the relationship between faith and divine action is reciprocal. As followers of Christ we are called to fully trust in Jesus and God's divine will. By trusting in God's plan for our lives we open ourselves to the fullness of God's grace and power.

Do we sometimes fail to recognize the divine presence working in our lives everyday? Do we lack confidence in God's plan for you? Today's reading asks us to reflect and see beyond surface appearance and be open to the extraordinary. Difficult as it may be ask and call out to the Holy Spirit to increase your faith in God's plan.

Aunque la gente del pueblo inicialmente estaba asombrada por toda su sabiduría y los milagros que estaba realizando, su atención rápidamente se volvió escéptica y cuestionada. A pesar de que estaban viendo milagros, les faltaba gravemente de fe. La gente del pueblo se preguntaba cómo un simple carpintero podía tener tal autoridad.

¿Cómo podía alguien a quien conocieron la mayor parte de su vida ser divino? Su falta de fe los cegó de la naturaleza y misión divina de Jesús.

Jesús también nos muestra cómo la falta de fe de la gente del pueblo lo limitó en cuanto a lo que podía hacer. Subraya la importancia de que la relación entre fe y acción divina sea recíproca. Como seguidores de Cristo estamos llamados a confiar plenamente en Jesús y en la voluntad divina de Dios. Al confiar en el plan de Dios para nuestras vidas, nos abrimos a la plenitud de la gracia y el poder de Dios.

¿A veces no reconocemos la presencia divina que actúa en nuestras vidas todos los días? ¿Nos falta confianza en el plan de Dios para usted? La lectura de hoy nos pide reflexionar y ver más allá de la apariencia superficial y estar abiertos a lo extraordinario. Por difícil que sea, pide y clama al Espíritu Santo para aumentar tu fe en el plan de Dios.
