REFLECTION CORNER

Christ the King What is Truth?

When we celebrate Christ the King, we are not talking about political power. That is the only kind of king that Pilate recognized. Our first two readings describe in poetic terms what Christ's kingdom is like: a priestly kingdom of glory and power that will never end. Pilate was judging the One who would one day judge him. He wanted to know if Jesus claimed to be a king, or if the Jews who wanted Jesus destroyed were behind the rumors of kingship. Jesus does not deny his kingship; after all, he says his purpose in life is the Truth. If you were reading this in the Bible, you would see Pilate's response, "What is truth?"

For Jesus (and for us), truth is the relationship between God and God's people. God is the source of the universe, the source of all life. Jesus came to show us the truth of God's love for all people. The divine kingdom is simply the way that we relate to God and each other. We join that kingdom, not by signing a membership list, but by living a life of love: Love for God and for each other.

So why doesn't Jesus use all that power and glory to make everyone follow him? Because God asks us to be humble like Jesus. God doesn't force people to believe. That is another side of Truth: who God is and who we are. If you believe in God, you begin to see God in people whom you love, people who need our help, even people who don't like us. We even see God in the beauty and majesty of creation. A few years ago, when I heard that scientists were coming to accept that the universe was infinite, I was afraid that that would make people reject the idea of God. But then it occurred to me that an all-powerful God would make an infinite universe to show the divine glory.

Today Jesus invites us to accept the truth and become members of his kingdom. The tax is what we freely choose to give; the army are those who freely give themselves in service to the poor, the sick, and those who are seeking God. And the laws of this Kingdom are simple—Love God with all your being and love your neighbor as yourself. And that's the Truth.

Cristo Rey ¿Qué es la verdad?

Cuando celebramos a Cristo Rey, no estamos hablando de poder político. Ese es el único tipo de rey que Pilato reconoció. Las primeras dos lecturas describen en términos poéticos cómo es el reino de Cristo: un reino sacerdotal de gloria y poder que nunca terminará. Pilato estaba juzgando a Aquel que un día lo juzgaría a él. Quería saber si Jesús afirmaba ser rey, o si los judíos que querían destruirlo estaban detrás de los rumores de realeza. Jesús no niega su realeza; después de todo, dice que su propósito en la vida es la Verdad. Si estuvieras leyendo esto en la Biblia, verías la respuesta de Pilato: "¿Qué es la verdad?"

Para Jesús (y para nosotros), la verdad es la relación entre Dios y el pueblo de Dios. Dios es la fuente del universo, la fuente de toda vida. Jesús vino a mostrarnos la verdad del amor de Dios por todas las personas. El reino divino es simplemente la forma en que nos relacionamos con Dios y entre nosotros. Nos unimos a ese reino, no firmando una lista de miembros, sino viviendo una vida de amor: amor a Dios y a los demás.

Entonces, ¿por qué Jesús no utiliza todo ese poder y gloria para hacer que todos lo sigan? Porque Dios nos pide que seamos humildes como Jesús. Dios no obliga a la gente a creer. Ese es el otro lado de la Verdad: quién es Dios y quiénes somos nosotros. Si crees en Dios, comienzas a ver a Dios en las personas que amas, en las personas que necesitan ayuda, incluso en las personas que no nos caen bien. Incluso vemos a Dios en la belleza y esplendor de la creación. Hace unos años, cuando escuché que los científicos estaban comenzando a aceptar que el universo era infinito, tenía miedo que eso iba a causar que la gente rechazara la idea de Dios. Pero luego se me ocurrió que un Dios todopoderoso haría un universo infinito para mostrar la gloria divina.

Hoy Jesús nos invita a aceptar la verdad y convertirnos en miembros de su reino. El impuesto es lo que elegimos libremente dar; el ejército son aquellos que se entregan libremente al servicio de los pobres, los enfermos y los que buscan a Dios. Y las leyes de este Reino son sencillas: amar a Dios con todo tu ser y amar al prójimo como a ti mismo. Y eso es la Verdad.



Jesus is a good king who loves His people so much that He died so we could go to Heaven.


What can you do to show Jesus that He is the king of your life? What can you do to show other people that Jesus is your king?





Christ the King Crossword




